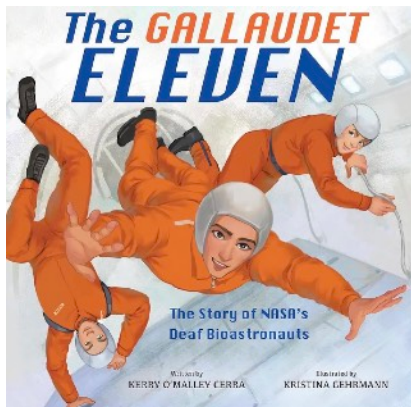

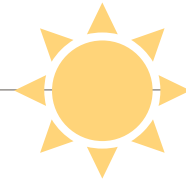
Recommended Reading-
